

I don't have a huge volume of email, but I do like to keep old emails for a year or two for reference (yes, I'm a pack rat). I found that just leaving them in my mailboxes wasn't a very convenient solution. The contents got too big, and Apple Mail's simple search capabilities often resulted in too many hits which I had to wade through to find what I wanted.

MailSteward is a very useful application for archiving email, *including attachments*, in a searchable database. It has multiple field "and/or" searching which is fast and quite easy to use. It comes in two versions, MailSteward Lite and the full version, MailSteward. The major features and differences between the versions are summarized below.

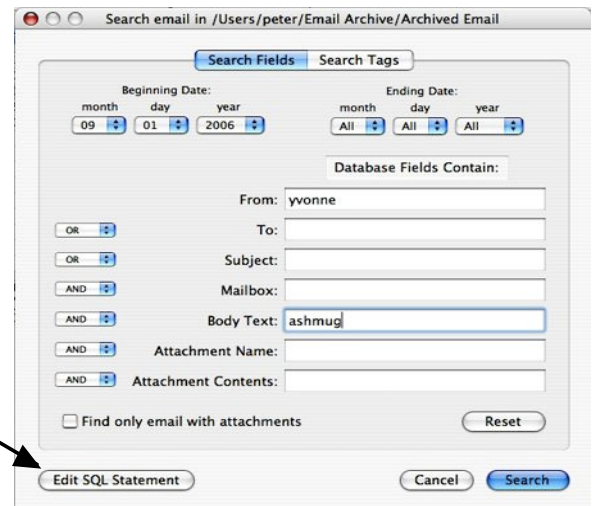

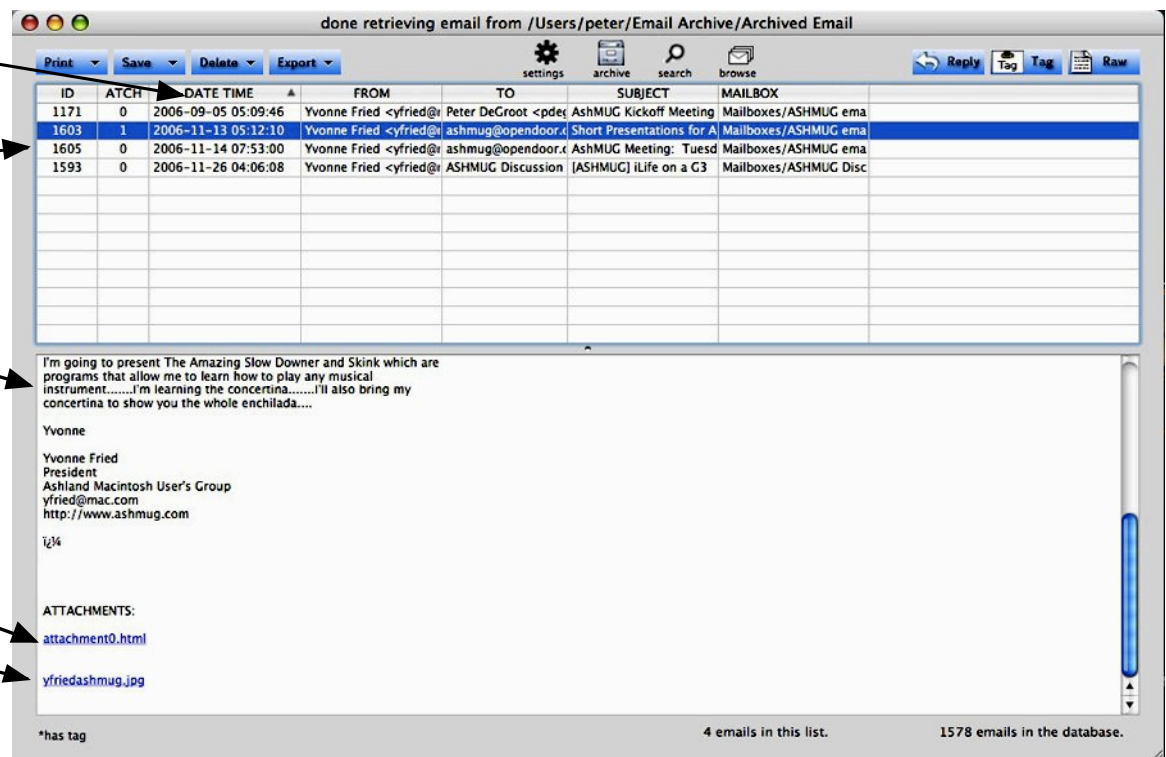
