

Downloading Files From Sendspace and Emailing Them to Someone Else

[Sendspace](#) is a service for pseudo-emailing large files to another person. Person A uploads a file to Sendspace, provides Person B's email address, and Sendspace sends an email with the link to download the file to B. There are three ways for B to download the file from this email which result in the physical file being copied to B's computer, by default to the Downloads folder.

Note that you can *Play* mp3's and videos right on the Sendspace download page, but this leaves the music file itself on Sendspace server.

Normally you would want to download the music to your computer.

You can do this by clicking one of the two Download buttons in this window or use one of the methods on the next page.

There are 2 more ways to download the file.

1) Simply click on the download link.

2) Right-click (or Control-click) on the same link to get the popup menu shown.

2a) Then click on one of the two Saved Linked File items.

2b) If you click on Copy Link you will just copy the link shown, not the file itself. Normally you probably don't want to do this, but see below.*



Re-sending

Find the file on your computer, either in the Downloads folder or wherever you chose to put it if you used the Save Linked File As... option.

If the file is small enough to be sent by email (less than about 5MB) just drag and drop this file into an email to send to someone else, as Todd Derek explained at the meeting.

*If the file is too big, you could upload it from your computer to SendSpace and send it that way, but there is an easier method. The file is already on SendSpace so you don't have to upload it again. Just go to step 2b above, copy the link, and Paste it into your email. The recipient will be able to download the file from this link.
