

How to Have a Less Expensive iPhone

To everyone who is interested,

The company where you can get inexpensive cell phone service is called Consumer Cellular and their URL is consumercellular.com. If you want to use an iPhone with Consumer Cellular you "do not" need to unlock your iPhone or jailbreak the iPhone. All you need to do is exchange the simcard from your Consumer Cellular phone to your iPhone.

If you're going to use an iPhone 4, then you need to have a modification done to the Sim card that comes in the Consumer Cellular phone. To get this modification done to the card go to Mobile Madness in Medford at exit 30 Highway 62 right next to the Fred Meyer main entrance. Take your Sim card into Mobile Madness tell them you need it cut down to fit in an iPhone 4. They will cut it down for you no charge will take all of two or three minutes.

If you want to use data on your iPhone with Consumer Cellular it will be need to be unlocked. If you're outside of your contract with AT&T you can have AT&T unlock the phone for you. Contact your local AT&T store to check that out.

Remember this is something that works for me I hope it works for you and allows you to save money but please carefully check out the services offered by Consumer Cellular and everything that is required before you make the decision to go down this road.
